Math, Science, Social Studies

We will be looking at polygons 3 sided through 12 sided. We will spend several days on Quadrilaterals (4 sided polygons). The next test is Scheduled for Tuesday, May 10th. It will cover the material listed above.</p> <p>We will be learning about tessellations and doing an art activity. Each student will need a white poster board that measures 22 by 24. These can be found at CVS, Walmart, etc. Please do not send a large sheet of poster board or one cut in half. The specifications make this activity work well.
